Reading

Complete the RACE writing paper attached. Mrs. Scheffler worked with you on RACE writing, during third grade, so you should be familiar with it.

Question that you need to answer: ***What was the journey like to America?***

R--Restate--Restate the question by turning it into a statement.

A--Answer--Answer the question completely.

C--Cite text evidence--Use examples and evidence from the text. You could start your Evidence with:
According to the text, “ _____.” or The author stated, “ _____.”

E--Explain your thinking--Explain how the evidence supports your answer. Give more details. You could start your Explanation with: This means _____. (or) This shows _____.

Fiction-- Please read at least one by any of the following authors: Rick Riordan (Percy Jackson and the Olympians series), Jenny Nimmo (Charlie Bones Series), Beverly Cleary, Louis Sachar, or Roald Dahl and take an AR quiz on it.

Math – Practice your Math Facts daily. It is critical that you know your multiplication tables, through the 12’s. We will begin timed tests in October. The multiplication tables are the foundation of 4th grade math. Summertime is a great time to practice these skills. You need to only spend 5-10 minutes/day reviewing them. Play “Multiplication War” with a family member (by multiplying the numbers of the cards you each flip over), use flash cards if you have them at home, get on <https://xtramath.org/#/home/index>. A little practice goes a long way, and being fluent with your math skills will make fourth grade math so much simpler for you!

Social Studies - You will need to know your states and capitals and abbreviations. I have attached a sheet for you to practice over the summer.

ACCELERATED READER PROGRAM

All Saints Academy students in Grades 1-4 use the Accelerated Reader Program to enhance the reading program at school. After students read a book, they log onto their account to take a quiz. Students have accessed Accelerated Reader at school and can access it at home.

During our remote learning, we have gained access to myON Shared Account and myON News. Students in Preschool through Grade 8 may access these reading books.

- The myOn Shared Account includes thousands of engaging digital books, for both online and offline reading. Many of these titles also have Accelerated Reader quizzes.
- The myOn News provides five news articles each weekday. Articles are written specifically for kids, cover a range of topics, and are reviewed by a child psychologist for appropriateness.

Upon completing a book on myOn Shared Account, students log into their Accelerated Reader account to take the quiz. Be sure to pick a book that has an Accelerated Reader quiz available.
